As many of you remember from our February Newsletter, we shared that our ministry vehicle had quit working a few months ago. This made complications in taking the sick kids to the hospital this year, not mention over 30 children to care for in Bungoma Children's Home, as well as transportation to all the ministry outreaches we had planned. We have learned to be creative with getting from A to B.

But now, Praise God, We have a new vehicle because of your generosity. We where able to raise \$20,000 from our Partners and \$10,000 from our ministry. Due to the tariff being 100%, we were able to buy a Toyota Land Cruiser for \$15,000 and paid tariff of \$15,000 to purchase it.
