After receiving Paul in our home we headed over to America to bless the Body of Christ and raise funds to continue to care for our Children like Paul. It is the financial support of our American brothers and sisters in Christ that allows us to care for and save more children from the streets.

(Our girls thought that all the big buildings on the strip were churches until they got a little older.) Mama Doris preached a message in front of the curtain, but behind the curtain was the ice rink for the show, so it was quite a challenge for her to stay warm. We met her after service and immediately began supporting the work of building the Bible school. We have stayed with the ministry through building the school's second story, the Children's Home, and the well. Each year Mama Doris would come to the US to raise funds and we always enjoyed her visits. She would always invite us to come to Africa to "get your joy back". When we visit, we find that it is true. Now, we are grateful to help in the continuation of this wonderful ministry in Bungoma through Bungoma Bible Ministries."
