In Bungoma, education is not public as it is in America. A family will have to sacrifice everything to place their child in school. Here, we believe that education is a gateway for the children's future.

To send Edwin to school, it will cost \$1,200 a year for him to receive quality education. Edwin is a dedicated student that works hard to achieve his goals. We are actively training up the children to become productive and prosperous men of God.

Edwin is only one of 4 boys from our school who are currently entering High School. So each child will cost \$1,200 a year, with 4 years to complete their education. Our younger children are not long in following Edwin into High School as well. Only \$100 a month will supply these Children with an education and a future to become all that they desire to be - to "achieve my goals" as Edwin said.
