High School education is not common in Kenya. It is costly and is only available as a boarding school. The costs for the education, boarding, and feeding of the students must be paid for by the parents. In this case

The costs of high school education is \$1,200 a year per students. We have 11 boys that are excellent students - at the top of their class. They are excellent ground to sow into. We are planing to raise a total of \$13,200 for one year of school - \$1,200 times 11 boys.
