- We have had the great privileged of growing Word of Life Fellowship to over 3 services in English and Swahili languages, holding conferences with over 1,000 attendee's from all over Africa, and it is self-supported.
- We have grown the children's home to over 30 children.
- We have continued the outreach to the street kids and minister weekly to over 100 children.
- Bungoma Bible School still continues to have free tuition for the student and is growing each semester in numbers. Many gifted Bible believing ministers have gone out from the school to preach and teach the Gospel.

This is all because of your continued financial support to Bungoma Bible Ministries. As Kenya is still an emerging nation, it is beginning to show signs of modernization. The School compound has tried to remain current on our current budget.

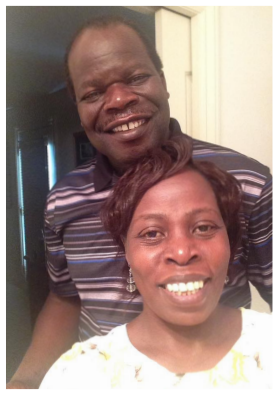
