Street Children Ministry

Over the last few months, we have experienced an increase of street children in the town. This increase has occurred because many families are unable to feed their children. This has caused many of the boys to leave their homes and come into the city to find food. They are eating scraps of what has been thrown in the garbage and beg in the streets.

We have seen an increase in Bungoma specifically because the street boys that we have been feeding these last few years have been spreading the word to other towns that in Bungoma there are ministries that will feed these children.

While we are saddened by the conditions that have caused this response, we are overjoyed with the privilege of serving these street children, touching their lives every week and feeding them as much as we possibly can. We have had the privilege of now feeding over 70 boys almost everyday.

Children Home

We have been home schooling for 3 months now. Our school year runs from February through November. Right now we are told that school will not be going back in session until possibly September or the start of the new year in January. This means we will be home schooling for at least another 3 months if not the remaining of the school year. It has been an interesting challenge learning to design home schooling programs and curriculums for the boys, but we have grown in the process.

One beautiful benefit of this time together is that these boys have learned to work together and support one another. They have been learning life skills together such as doing chores, learning to wash and clean, doing laundry for the boys, and some even trying it for the first time! We have shared a lot of roles over this time and the boys have grown so much with these new challenges.

At this time we are unable to have guests or invite people to the children's home. Therefore we have had to be very creative when it comes to playing and doing all our home activities with the children. It is certain that we learn so much more before September or January comes and our boys return to school.

We want to thank you for your continued prayers and financial support for Bungoma Bible Ministries. The increased costs in this season we have seen the Lord provide through your faithfulness.
