Rigan Nyaberi and Morgan Barongo are twin brothers. Both are 3 years old. They have come from the village of Riosugo in Kisii, Central Southern Part of Kenya. They have lost both of their parents and their grandparents to sickness.

According to the social worker, who brought them to us, their Father, Isaiah Nyaberi suffered epilepsy throughout his life and passed away in 2021 from an HIV infection. It was only one year later that their mother, Irene Barongo passed away as well. The Tribal Chief said both of the boys grandparents had already passed before they were even born.

Both Rogan and Morgan lived with an Uncle for 3 years, who already had a large family of 9 children. Because of so many children to feed, their Uncle was unable to continue to provide for their well being.

We have been blessed with two of the most sweet, kind, and loving boys with Rigan and Morgan. They both speak Swahili as well as Guise, their tribal language. We are preparing them for school where they will learn english and grow in knowledge.

We are looking forward to providing them a joyful experience in the Children's Home, a happy life with Biblical education and all the love from our House Family, Margaret and I. We know they will be taught in the way of our Lord Jesus Christ and come to experience His love for them!
